OBJECTIVE

The objective of the scholarship is to develop students' awareness of the property/casualty actuarial field and to encourage the pursuit of the FCAS and FCIA designations. OCCA is a regional affiliate of the Casualty Actuarial Society.

AWARD DESCRIPTION

The OCCA Scholarship Program will award up to four \$1,000 scholarships to students who are currently enrolled at a University in the province of Ontario, and who will be enrolled in an Actuarial Science program at a University in the province of Ontario for the 2010-2011 academic year. An applicant must have demonstrated high scholastic achievement and a strong interest in the property/casualty insurance industry.

AWARD REQUIREMENTS

- A detailed resume
- A 150 to 200-word short essay discussing why you are interested in the property/casualty actuarial field
- A current official transcript

Completed applications are due by March 31, 2010.
