### **Notes for Faculty and Staff:**

No member of the Board of Governors whose salary is paid under a Collective Agreement or Memorandum of Agreement between the University and a union or employee association may serve as a member of any team negotiating matters related to the remuneration or benefits, terms of employment, rights or privileges available to employees in a class or group of employees of the University.

Any faculty member elected to the Board of Governors will not be a member of the UWOFB bargaining unit as set out in the Collective Agreement.

In accordance with the Collective Agreement between UWOFB and the University, a faculty member may not simultaneously be a Department Chair and a member of the Board of Governors.

Candidates, or their representatives, must attend the Mandatory All Candidates' Meeting.
