CAT ON A HOT TIN ROOF

LONDON, ON: Theatre Western is proud to present Tennessee Williams' Tony-nominated play, *Cat on a Hot Tin Roof* from November 28th to December 1st, 2007. For the first time ever in London, the Theatre Western production will be performed at McManus Theatre and features a cast and crew comprised of Western students and members of the London community.

This dramatic play conveys the story of an American family in flux. Over the course of one evening gathering, the show depicts the turbulent relationship of a wife and husband, Maggie "The Cat" and Brick Pollitt, and their interaction with Brick's family at their Louisiana estate.

Cat on a Hot Tin Roof is directed and produced by some of the most talented students amongst Western's undergraduate population.

"We are excited to be producing such a noteworthy script, and to have such dynamic actors taking it to the McManus stage," says Alex Paterson, Theatre Western Coordinator for the University Students' Council.
