The conference will also be attracting several notable speakers. Dr. Charles Trick, Ivey Chair of Ecosystem Health, Hans Schreff of London Hydro, and Evon Peter, the National Director of Native Movement.

"Our goal is to continue supporting and expanding strong, active, student-oriented networks regionally, nationally and internationally, and support their grassroots campaigns," said Jordan Kemp, the conference coordinator.

The conference will also include an evening event on Saturday with musical guests at the Grad Club. Each event and keynote speaker is open to the public, costing \$5 at the door.

"It is not very often that Western is given the privilege to host such an event committed to environmental sustainability and how to make our campus greener".
